No school business will be transacted on holidays and during vacation.

SCHOOL FEES

The school fees cover twelve calendar months and may be paid in installments. No deduction is made for holidays or broken periods. The fees must be paid on or before the 20th of each month, falling which a late fee of Rs.20/- per month will be levied. All dues must be paid before the final assessment.

Students whose fees are long overdue may be barred from sitting for an exam, and are liable to have their names struck of the rolls.

If the delay in payment of fees exceeds two months the student is liable to sent back home without further notification. Delay in payment of fees may incur the students dismissal from school.

SCHOOL UNIFORM

Every student must wear a clean, complete and correct uniform daily. Defaulters may be fined or sent back home.

SUMMER UNIFORM

For Boys : Sky blue half-sleeved shirt, deep navy blue with sky blue striped

Tie & Logo, deep navy blue trousers / shorts with belt, black

shoes (with lace), white socks & navy blue School Bag.

For Girls : Sky blue half sleeved front open top with shirt collar, deep navy

blue pleated Skirt with Belt, deep navy blue with sky blue striped Tie & Logo, black shoes (Ballerina), white socks. White ribbons

& navy blue School Bag.

WINTER UNIFORM

For Boys: Sky blue full-sleeved shirt and deep navy blue

trousers, Tie, Logo, Belt, Shoes, socks and Bag

same as above and navy blue pullover.

For Girls: Sky blue full sleeved front open top with shirt

collar and deep navy blue pleated Skirt with Tie, Logo, Belt, Shoes, Socks, Ribbon and Bag same

as above and navy blue pullover or cardigan.

Karate : White Shirt, white trousers / shorts, white socks, white keds & other same as above for Boys.

White front open top with shirt colour, white pleated skirt, white Socks, white keds and others

same as above for girls.

ADMISSIONS, WITHDRAWALS AND DISMISSAL

New admission are taken only for Nursery class. Other admission if any, will depend on the availability of seats and on the competence of the student. Information regarding admission to Nursery and other class can be had from the School Office in the first week of October.

Selection is made on the basis of test and interview so as to determine the capability of the child to pursue the prescribed coursed of study.

Guardian are asked to fill in the admission form with utmost accuracy and produce No.5 passport size Photo and original with one Xerox copy of birth Certificate of the child from the Municipality or Corporation.

A student who has attend recognizes school cannot be admitted without transfer certificate from the school he/she last attended. All the student withdrawing a student from the school a month's notice is to be given.

The transfer certificate will be given on payment of transfer fee. No certificate will be issued until all dues to the school have been paid in full.

$The following student will be {\it dismissed} from {\it the school}:$

- a] Those who fail two years in succession in the same class.
- b] Those whose attendance is irregular.
- c] Those whose conduct is injurious to the moral tone of the school, are dishonest or disobededient.
